First toy that accommodates color vision diversity to obtain Color Universal Design (CUD) certification!

Steering wheel toy that enables driving experiences with your favorite "TOMICA" <u>"Let's Drive TOMICA! Handle Driver"</u> To be launched on Saturday, April 20, 2024

Features to ensure play accessibility including readily distinguishable color scheme, tactile design elements, and voice navigation

TOMY Company, Ltd. (Representative Director, President & COO: Kazuhiro Kojima, headquarters: Katsushika-ku, Tokyo) will release the "Let's Drive TOMICA! Handle Driver" (SRP: JPY 6,820/tax included) steering wheel toy that enables driving experiences with your favorite "TOMICA" in serving as a new product that provides more extensive play involving "TOMICA" die-cast miniature car series. It will be released on Saturday, April 20, 2024, at toy stores, toy sections of department stores/mass retailers in Japan, the specialty store for TOMICA products "TOMICA shop," online stores, TOMY Company's official online store "Takara Tomy Mall" (takaratomymall.jp/), etc.

With "Let's Drive TOMICA! Handle Driver," a user positions his or her favorite "TOMICA" (miniature car) into the main unit to engage in play that involves pretending to do car-related jobs and experiencing the fun of driving while operating the steering wheel following on-screen and audio instructions. In job mode, you can position one of the included game sheet overlays on the screen and take on three different mission-oriented challenges: police car, fire truck, and race car. In endless drive mode, you can enjoy driving with radio-like audio playing in the background. It is equipped with approximately 100 different sounds that liven up the driving atmosphere. You can also position a smartphone in front of the screen to watch your favorite driving simulation video^(*1) while enjoying the driving experience. "Let's Drive TOMICA! Handle Driver" constitutes the first toy to have been granted Color Universal Design (CUD) certification^(*2) for assuring that the product accommodates color vision diversity. It was evaluated highly for features such as its "readily distinguishable color scheme" and its "playability without the need to perceive colors."

TOMY Company promotes development of "accessible-design toys"^(*3) designed to be enjoyable for children with and without visual/auditory disabilities, regardless of their abilities. This product is also "Guide Dog Mark" certified as a toy that children with visual disabilities can also enjoy. These efforts have involved ensuring that the toy incorporates features that accommodate color vision diversity to make it fun for even more children. CUD principles for accommodating color vision diversity have been adopted in various fields amid a situation where it has been estimated that more than 3.2 million people in Japan nationwide have difficulty identifying colors, thereby affecting some one in 20 men and one in 500 women in Japan^(*4).

Distinctive features of "Let's Drive TOMICA! Handle Driver"

<u>• Drive your favorite TOMICA!</u>

Position your own "TOMICA" in the vehicle mounting component of the main unit to experience driving that involves operating the toy's steering wheel and gear shifter. It is compatible with TOMICA cars of various widths, with some exceptions.

* TOMICA (miniature cars) are sold separately. One dummy car is included with the product.

<u>• Various types of voice and sound effect audio liven up the driving experience!</u>

Equipped with approximately 100 sound effects and over 1,000 voice patterns that help you with navigation and also liven up the driving atmosphere.

o Job mode: Take on work vehicle mission-oriented challenges!

Select from one of the three game sheet overlays included with the toy to play mission-oriented games involving three working vehicles (police car, fire truck, and race car).





Become a police officer on patrol using your steering wheel to engage in pursuit of thieves.



Become a firefighter struggling to put out fires by aiming the hose at the fire using the gear shifter and steering wheel.

• Endless drive mode: Enjoy the feeling of driving with radio-like audio playing in the background!

Enjoy the pure driving experience without use of a game sheet overlay. Plenty of radio-like audio plays to liven up the driving atmosphere.

Also, position a smartphone in front of the screen to watch your favorite driving simulation video while enjoying the driving experience.

<u>• First toy product with CUD certification for accommodating color</u> vision diversity

"Let's Drive TOMICA! Handle Driver" is the first toy with CUD certification assuring that it accommodates color vision diversity upon having been highly evaluated for features such as its "readily distinguishable color scheme" and its "playability without the need to perceive colors," per verification performed by Color Universal Design Organization, a non-profit organization.

<Key points associated with Color Universal Design> "Let's Drive TOMICA! Handle Driver" accommodates color vision diversity through use of highly visible and readily identifiable color combinations.

Game sheet overlay front (left) and back (right)



Its game sheet overlay design incorporates readily identifiable outlines and contrasts to facilitate perception of colors that are otherwise not easily distinguishable, such as when dark red and black are perceived as the same color.

• Accessible-design toy that people with visual disabilities are able to enjoy

"Let's Drive TOMICA! Handle Driver" has received "Guide Dog Mark" certification as an "accessibledesign toy" promoted by the Japan Toy Association as a toy enjoyable together with people with visual disabilities.







Become a race car driver and experience car racing that involves overtaking cars of your opponents using the gear shifter and steering wheel.



Position a smartphone in front of the screen to experience driving while watching driving simulation video





<Key points associated with accessible-design toy certification>

- Audio cues are used to navigate users through operation instructions and gameplay content.
- Control buttons feature a variety of shapes and are positioned in readily accessible locations.
- Three different game sheet overlays are designed to enable tactile recognition of overlay type and overlay front and back surfaces.
