In commemoration of the new "TOMICA" Happy Meal that will be released on Friday, April 11, 2025, McDonald's Company (Japan), Ltd. (Representative Director, President and CEO: Thomas Ko, headquarters: Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo; hereinafter McDonald's), TOYOTA GAZOO Racing (hereinafter TGR), and TOMY Company, Ltd. (Representative Director, President & CEO: Akio Tomiyama, headquarters: Katsushika-ku, Tokyo; hereinafter TOMY Company) will collaborate once again to launch the special TOMICA Happy Meal Project, which was well-received last year.

The "TOMICA" Happy Meal special project is based on McDonald's philosophy of "delivering that signature McDonald's FUN" and "bolstering the happiness of families by supporting the growth and development of children," combined with TGR's desire to "share the 'dreams' and 'inspiration' of cars to customers" and "that cars will continue to make children's hearts flutter for another 100 years," as well as TOMY Company's aim to "foster children's creativity, provide opportunity to learn how society works and strengthen family bonds through TOMICA." Under the shared wish to



"support children's dreams," the three companies are collaborating to create special content for families to enjoy learning the society together.



This year's "TOMICA" Happy Meal toys will feature a lineup of working vehicles and popular vehicles, along with rolling out various collaboration initiatives.

First, starting on Friday, April 18, a special movie titled "GO! GR SUPRA SAFETY CAR!" will be released on the TOYOTA GAZOO Racing official YouTube channel, featuring the Toyota GR Supra Safety Car in action on a circuit.

Additionally, for 3 days during the Golden Week period, Saturday, April 26, Sunday, April 27, and Saturday, May 3 (holiday), a hands-on event called "Happy Meal Exciting Tour*," offering a special "thrilling and exciting" experience for families (children plus accompanying adults) will be held. Applications will be accepted beginning on Friday, April 4, and a total of 90 children will be selected by lottery to participate over the three days.

*The "Happy Meal Exciting Tour" is a collaboration project between McDonald's and TGR, with cooperation from TOMY.

Additionally, from Friday, April 25 to Sunday, May 11, selected McDonald's locations will feature a real-life display of the "Toyota GR Supra Safety Car" McDonald's original design, as well as a display of nostalgic "TOMICA" Happy Meal toys from years past.

*The "Toyota GR Supra Safety Car" will appear in the second installment of the "TOMICA" Happy Meal series, which will be released on Friday, April 25.

"TOMICA" Happy Meal feature all TOMICA cars with unique mechanisms (gimmicks) that reflect the characteristics of each vehicle, making them fun toys to play with by rolling them by hand.
